DECLARATION OF JEAN-MARC SELLEN
Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746


1. My name is Jean-Marc Sellen and I reside in Stouffville, Ontario, Canada. The following facts are known to me personally and if called as a witness I could and would competently testify thereto.
2. In late February of 2009 I received a phone call from an individual who claimed that his company could lower my credit card interest rates. He told me his name was Sam Anderson and that he worked for a company called MCS Program Services ("MCS"). I asked Mr. Anderson where he was calling from. He told me that MCS was based in Dallas, Texas in the United States of America. I asked him for more information on his company. He told me to visit their website and he gave me the website address: www.mcsprograms.com. Mr. Anderson gave me MCS' toll-free customer service number, (866) 945-1131, as well as his extension (271).
3. He asked me for my credit card information. By this time I was beginning to suspect that his company was fraudulent so I refused to give the information to him. I told him I wasn't interested in his company's service and hung up.
4. After hanging up, I saw that the caller ID on my phone indicated that the call had come from (514) 908-9713. I recognized that as a Montreal phone number and this made me even more suspicious.

5. Over the next two weeks or so I received two or three more calls from people saying they represented MCS. Soon after the second or third call, I contacted Phonebusters to file a complaint.

6. I received several calls from MCS telemarketers during March. Each time I would tell them that I wasn't interested and ask them to stop calling. For a couple of weeks I just stopped answering calls that came from numbers that were unidentified by my caller ID or otherwise suspect. When I resumed answering all of my calls, I received one or two additional calls from MCS. I just repeated that I was not interested and did not want them to continue calling. I haven't heard from MCS since approximately early April of 2009.
